



Course Description

(Eurythmics 1, 2, 3, 4/Dance Repertory 1, 2, 3 Honors, 4 Honors)

Students participating in the Color Guard are **REQUIRED TO TAKE THE CLASS.** The group meets as a class every other day. Students will receive specialized instruction on flag, rifle, and sabre, as well as dance. All members are part of the **EAGLE REGIMENT** to all

performances which include football games, parades, evaluations and competitions.

This ensemble turns into the competitive winterguard program the second semester. We have an audition, in order to

separate the performers into two separate groups. One competing in World class and the other in A class. The guards compete in the South Florida Winter Guard Association and Winter Guard International. The class final is our **END of** the YEAR RECITAL in May.







- -Prerequisite is participation in Marching Band & Winter Guard
- -Primary weapon spots are awarded to students participating in fall & winter season and is at the Directors discretion.


PRE REQUISTES

Upon the completion of this course the student will be able to:


- Perform basic to intermediate ballet skills such as Tendu, Plies, Releve, and Frappes.

PROCEDURES FOR TEACHER/STUDENT CONFERENCES:



DAILY CLASS ATTIRE

Becoming a high level performer means you must train as one. The proper clothing for class, rehearsal and performances is **KEY** to being a great color guard. Please review the information regarding our dress policies.

- NO GUM
- NO dangling/loose earrings or necklaces.
- Hair must be up and out of your face.
- YOU MUST BE IN DRESS CODE AT ALL TIMES (especially shorts and tanks.)

MARCHING BAND REHERSAL ATTIRE

Students are expected to be in their attendance block on time with equipment, dot books, pencils, etc. for all rehearsals

*Members are **REQUIRED** to wear their practice uniform attire with proper footwear.

*Hair should be pulled back away from the face.

REHEARSALSPERFORMANCES



GUIDELINES

- Except in cases of extreme emergency, death in the family, religious holidays or illness, guard members will not be excused from rehearsals or performances.
- In case of illness, students are expected to contact a Guard Captain as early as possible so that substitutions or replacements can be made.
- Appointments, meetings, lack of rides, work, vacations, etc... will not be valid excuses for missing a rehearsal or performance.
- A written excuse from the parent or guardian is due within two days of the absence.
- If you anticipate an unavoidable absence from a rehearsal or performance, please submit a written request to Mr. Broadbent prior to the intended absence.
- All tardies and absences affect a student's grade because of lost instruction time that cannot be "made up".



BOTH colorguard & winterguard

- 1. If you are absent from a practice, no matter what the reason, it is your responsibility to learn all the work and checkpoints that you missed.
- 2. You must do this BEFORE practice, not DURING practice!
- **3.** Failure to abide by this simple rule may result in the revocation of your performance privileges

(and your grade will be altered accordingly.)

Marching Band Requirements





Students are expected to....

be in their attendance block on time with equipment, dot books, pencils, etc...

- * Members are **REQUIRED** to wear their practice uniform attire with sneakers.
- Hair should be pulled back away from the face.
- No Jewelry!
 No Gum!
 Cell Phones on **SILENT!**
- Water bottles, dotbooks, gloves, drill charts, pencils and black/white electrical tape are required at every rehearsal.
- Stay for the entire practice. Late arrival and/or early departure will count as a tardy.
- Make arrangements for a ride

 BEFORE rehearsal. It is not fair for
 the staff to have to wait for your
 ride to arrive.

- All colorguard members will walk to/from the stadium together. *Members will sit in the stands in their sections.
- Non-Band Members are not allowed in the band section. Please explain this to friends, family, etc... Alumni who may return are always welcome, but will not be allowed to sit in with the block while in the stands.
- Students are not to leave the band area unless accompanied by a chaperone, except during 3rd quarter break.
- Students should stayin groups of 2 or more for your own safety.
- Cell phones are **NOT** to be used!

- While the other bands perform, Stoneman Douglas colorguard members are expected to be a supportive audience.
- A break will be given during the 3rd quarter of each game. You must be back, in place, by the end of 3rd quarter.
- Members may only change out of the performance uniform, for travel, if you have your warm-ups/travel uniform.

Winter Guard Requirements

- Students are expected to be in their attendance block on time with equipment...
- Members are required to wear form-fitting blacks as their rehearsal attire

(see pictures in earlier section of syllabus)

- **MEMBERS WEAR BLACK TO CLASS DURING WINTER GUARD.**
- Hair should be pulled back away from the face.

- Cell Phones on SILENT!
- * Water bottles, gloves, rehearsal journals, pencils and black/white electrical tape are required at every rehearsal.
- Nobody can leave until the floor is folded and the practice site is clean. Early departure will count as a tardy.

Uniforms

- 1. ALL costumes are the property of MEPA and need
- to be returned or an obligation for the cost of the costume.
 - 2. Every member is required to have a SPIRIT COSTUME which is theirs. They are used troughout the year for small events.
 - **3.** Every member must have a warm up jacket that comes with their name on it.

- 4. The captains will be responsible for inspections and will report directly to the director.
- 5. At the conclusion of each season performance costumes must be returned to MEPA in acceptable condition. Failure to do so will result in an obligation.
 - Students must follow BCPS Dress Code at all times when with the Stoneman Douglas Colorguard/Winterguard Program!
